In 2013, he was a member of the Brazilian Senate's Special External Commission, chaired by Justice Luis Felipe Salomão, which was formed to draw up the Arbitration and Mediation Bill. The bill, which became Law 13.129, reformed the Brazilian Arbitration Law in 2015.

In 2021, working with the Commission on Economic Development, Industry, Commerce and Services and other specialists, Chico helped to draft Law 14.195/2021, the "New Business Environment Law". He was particularly involved in the provisions dealing with multiple voting shares, resulting in an amendment to the Brazilian Corporations Law to expressly permit multiple voting share structures in Brazil.

He is the author of *Cartas a um Jovem Advogado* (Letters to a Young Lawyer) and *O Insider Trading in Brazilian Law* (Insider Trading in Brazilian Law).

Chico has lectured in Corporate Law at the law school of the Pontificia Universidade Católica do Rio de Janeiro – PUC/RJ since 1981, and at the law school of the Fundação Getúlio Vargas – FGV since 2005. He has been visiting professor at the Vanderbilt Law School since 2010, where he lectures an International Mergers and Acquisitions course. He is currently finishing his PhD at Goethe Universität Frankfurt, dissertation on dual class shares. In addition he holds a Master in Law from the Fundação Getulio Vargas -FGV (2015) and an LL.M from Harvard Law School (1979) recognized as a Master inLaw in Brazil.
