

*LU, Song* Professor of law emeritus Independent Arbitrator

Mr. LU Song is a professor emeritus of China Foreign Affairs University, a specially invited professor of the IADS program at the Law School of Tsinghua University and an independent arbitrator.

Graduated from the Law Department of Peking University (1982), from China Foreign Affairs University (1985) and Free University of Brussels (1986), he has taught law courses since 1986 at China Foreign Affairs University, later also at MIDS program of Geneva University and IADS program of Tsinghua Law School. He was a Fulbright Scholar at the law school of Stanford University (1995-96).

In 1989 he was admitted to practise Chinese law and also began serving as an arbitrator. Mr. Lu has sat as arbitrator in over 500 arbitrations under the arbitration rules of CIETAC, BAC/BIAC, SCIA, SHIAC, HKIAC, SIAC, ICC, UNCITRAL and CAS in a number of jurisdictions.

He is Vice President of China Commission of Arbitration for Sports ("CCAS"), a member of the International Commercial Expert Committee of the PRC Supreme People's Court and Vice President of the Arbitration and ADR Committee of ICC China.

Mr. Lu has served as the national reporter of China for ICCA Handbook (2008-2023) and he is a co-founder of Beijing International Arbitration Forum (BIAF).
